UDRC Rules – Revised 2026


DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: The Directors, Organisers, Urmston & District Riding Club, Committee or any persons acting on their behalf will not accept responsibility for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders or spectators or any person, animal, or property whatsoever from any cause.

1. All competitors in hand or ridden must have attained their 4th birthday by 1st January 2026.
2. Horses or ponies must be 4 years old or over to be ridden on the showground.
3. Membership is open until the 1st July 2026. Members will not be eligible to join after this date.
4. Ages of members are taken as their age on 1st January 2026.
5. Correct standard hard hats must be worn by all riders at **all times in all events**.
6. Whips exceeding 30 inches are not allowed. Excessive use of whips will result in **disqualification** and potentially removal from the showground.
7. Horses/Ponies must be in walk whilst on the showground, unless in the designated warm up area.
8. The Judge's decision is final.
9. It is the competitor's responsibility to be prepared for the class when it is called. If the competitor cannot enter the ring when it is called, they must inform the Judge or Steward of the circumstances. If the class is called and the competitor misses the class, no refunds will be given.
10. Individuals **must not** enter the class where the first trot is undergoing/completed. They will have deemed to have missed the class.
11. Entry fees will only be refunded should a show/class be cancelled.
12. All colts/stallions must be handled by an individual 14 years old or over.
13. Competitors are the only people permitted in the ring, with the exception of one responsible adult allowed to support a competitor in Tiny Tots, Novelty, or SEND classes.
14. The decision of the Committee is final and binding.
15. Entry fees must be paid before any horse or rider enters the ring.
16. Non Members cannot win any cup, trophy or shield. Non Members cannot compete in the Overall Supreme of Year and will not be nominated for the Rising Star Award.
17. All complaints or objections must be made in writing to the club secretary within 24 hours of the incident with a fee of £20.00 which will be refunded if upheld.
18. Any competitor deemed not in control of their animal will be asked to leave the showground. All dogs must be kept on leads.
19. The Committee reserves the right to remove/withhold membership from an individual deemed to be rude and/or abusive to the committee/stewards/judges.

20. We hold a no tolerance policy for bullying – in person/electronically/via social media. The Committee reserves the right to remove/withhold membership following investigation.
21. In order to represent UDRC in a class at STARS, you must be a UDRC member and been placed in that class at a minimum of 2 shows. To win prizes at the end of year presentation evening, competitors must have attended a minimum of 3 shows.
22. Combination numbers are given to each combination of animal and handler/rider. They are **not** transferable, and a new number must be given by the show secretary for a new combination. There are not to be substitutions of rider/handler/animal using the same combination number.
23. If during the season an animal measures into, and competes in, a different height section, previous points gained from competing in a different height section will be forfeited.
24. Please ensure that you have read the class criteria in the schedule. If you have entered the wrong class by mistake, speak to the secretary on the day **before** entering the class.
25. If a competitor enters and places in a class they are not eligible for, they will have points from that class forfeited.
26. Two in hand and two ridden competitors can be nominated by judges, stewards and committee members from each show to compete in the Rising Star Championship at the final show of the year. Nominees must not have attained their 18th birthday by 1st January 2026. The same person cannot be nominated twice. This championship is judged by a star judge that has not judged any classes or championships at our shows that year prior to the Rising Star Championship.
27. The Supreme of Year championship is open to all members that have been champion or reserve in the equitation, mini, in hand, ridden or working hunter championships at any UDRC shows that season.
28. The Novelty supreme is open to all members that have been champion or reserve in the novelty championships at any UDRC shows that season.
29. STARS qualifiers will be contacted after the final show to confirm attendance and entry details. Points will be posted on the Urmston & District Riding Club Facebook page after each show.

Map of UDRC Showground





Qualification Information:

STARS:

Qualification will be taken from points accrued over the season which give rise to your champion, reserve champion and 2nd res champion. Each club MUST offer the option of representing their club to each class champion. Should they be unable to attend you may pass down to res champion and 2nd res. Each club is allowed to send 1 competitor for each class. If you have 2 competitors with equal marks, then both qualify. All competitors must attend a minimum of 2 points shows. Final to be held at Aintree International Equestrian Centre in November 2026.

TSR Amateur of the Year:

The two highest placed exhibit not already qualified will qualify for the relevant TSR Amateur of the Year final class to be held at Stoneleigh Park, Warwickshire on 28 th and 29th November

1. COLOURED HORSE/PONY RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Ponies: Open Ridden Piebald/Skewbald, stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Spurs must not be worn. Ponies under 153 cms. Horses: Open Ridden Piebald/Skewbald, stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year Spurs may be worn by adult riders. Animals 153cms and over.

2. MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and Welsh B. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year and suitably mounted. Spurs must not be worn.

3. MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Fells, Dales, Highlands, New Forests, Connemara, Welsh C and Welsh D. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years and over. Riders any age except for those on stallions who must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year. Spurs must not be worn

4. LEAD REIN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mares or geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not have attained their 9 th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

5. FIRST RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A or B. Mares or geldings 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthdays but not attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

6. PLAITED PONY RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Open plaited pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Any suitably mounted rider. Spurs must not be worn

7. LEAD REIN PLAITED RIDDEN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Lead Rein Pony mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders to have attained their 3rd birthday but not their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

8. FIRST RIDDEN PLAITED AMATEUR OF THE YEAR First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 128cms. Riders to have attained their 3rd birthday but not their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

9. RIDDEN RIDING HORSE/HACK AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Open to Hacks and Riding Horses. mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms but Hacks not exceeding 160cms. Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show Spurs may be worn by adult riders

10. RIDDEN COB AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. To be shown hogged and trimmed. . Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show Spurs may be worn by adult riders

11. RIDDEN HUNTER AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exceeding 148cms. . Riders must have attained their 15th birthday by the day of the Show. Spurs may be worn by adult riders

12. RIDDEN VETERAN AMATEUR OF THE YEAR Open to horses and ponies of any breed, type and height, 15 years and over. Riders of any age, suitably mounted – animals will not be galloped. Spurs not to be worn. Blemishes are not taken into consideration.
